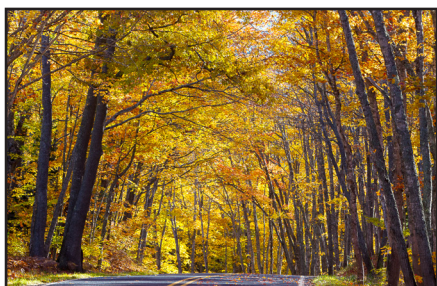

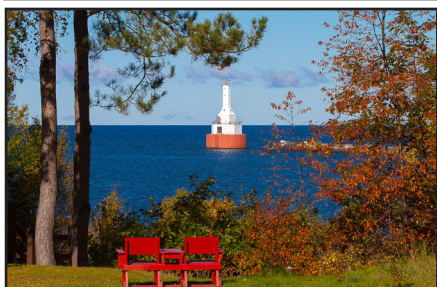
Photography Workshop in Keweenaw's Fall Color October 4 - 6, 2013.



Learn Photography while enjoying and photographing the great fall color found in Michigan's Keweenaw Peninsula with Bob Guiliani. The goal is to have you create some of your best images while learning and having fun. Bob & Linda have led workshops to Isle Royale National Park for the past five years with many participants returning each year to learn and enjoy.



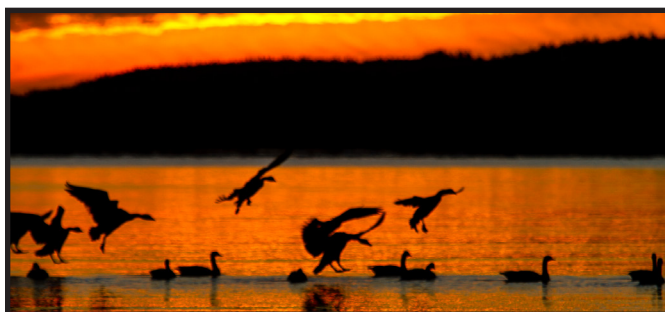
This photographic tour begins with introductions and overview of some basic photographic techniques at 12:30 p.m. Friday, October 4th and ending Sunday with discussions and critiques from 3 to 5 p.m. We'll base out of the Calumet area with driving excursions to the famous Brockway Mountain Drive, Lake Superior Shorelines, compositional views of local lighthouses, visit an old mine, enjoy an informative scenic boat ride along the waterway, plus sunrise and sunsets. This is truly a great time to be in Michigan's north country. There is a great photo waiting at nearly every turn.



The cost for the workshop is \$350, which includes the scenic boat ride. Meals and accommodations are the responsibility of each participant. Car-pooling to each of the areas is recommended. The timing of fall color and weather is unpredictable but previous experience suggests this to be close to peak color.

Bob has been photographing professionally for over 30 years and teaches photography at Mid Michigan Community College. He and his wife, Linda, own and operate a portrait studio and art gallery in Clare, MI. Bob's images have received national and state awards. He has given programs to various organizations, has been commissioned to do limited edition prints, has had his images published in various magazines, and has had solo exhibits. He prints all of his images himself so to have complete control of the final art piece. He is a Master Photographer, Photographic Craftsman and has a M.A. in chemistry.

Composition, HDR, depth of field, shutter speeds, exposure, seeing the light, and more will be discussed through the use of examples while in the field. The camera is just a tool to record what is in front of the lens. Pre-visualization before setting the tripod down and pushing the shutter is what creates stronger and more intriguing images. Bob will explain the whys and hows of the choices he makes before creating the image. Upon registration information on hotels, campgrounds and suggested equipment will be e-mailed.
